Grant awarding policy

1. Carlton Parish Council may make small donations to organisations which directly benefit the local area or some or all of its inhabitants. To be eligible for a grant the organisation must be charitable or non profit-making and will be expected to report on how the grant has been spent.
2. Carlton Parish Council may support local organisations in other ways, for example by providing facilities, equipment, logistical support, advertising, and helping with the recruitment of volunteers.
3. Carlton Parish Council does not make grants to individuals.
4. Carlton Parish Council does not make grants to national charities or relief funds on the grounds that it is a personal matter for parishioners to decide for themselves which if any charities to support. The Parish Council has no power to make donations to charities or funds which do not directly benefit residents of the United Kingdom.

This policy was adopted by Carlton Parish Council on 28th July 2010.
